

The Word of God

Exodus 9:20-22 ²⁰ The one among the servants of Pharaoh who feared the word of the LORD made his servants and his livestock flee into the houses; ²¹ but he who **paid no regard to the word of the LORD** left his servants and his livestock in the field.

Numbers 15:30-31 ³⁰ But the person who does *anything* defiantly, whether he is native or an alien, that one is blaspheming the LORD; and that person shall be cut off from among his people. ³¹ Because **he has despised the word of the LORD** and has broken His commandment, that person shall be completely cut off; his guilt *will be* on him.”

Deuteronomy 4:1-3 ⁴ “Now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the judgments which I am teaching you to perform, so that you may live and go in and take possession of the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, is giving you. ² **You shall not add to the word which I am commanding you, nor take away from it,** that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you. ³ Your eyes have seen what the LORD has done in the case of Baal-peor, for all the men who followed Baal-peor, the LORD your God has destroyed them from among you.

Deuteronomy 30:13-15 ¹³ Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, ‘Who will cross the sea for us to get it for us and make us hear it, that we may observe it?’ ¹⁴ **But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may observe it.**

Deuteronomy 32:46-47 ⁴⁶ he said to them, “ Take to your heart all the words with which I am warning you today, which you shall command your sons to observe carefully, *even* all the words of this law. ⁴⁷ For it is not an idle word for you; indeed it is your life. And by this word you will prolong your days in the land, which you are about to cross the Jordan to possess.”

Psalms 18:29-31

²⁹ For by You I can run upon a troop;
And by my God I can leap over a wall.

³⁰ As for God, His way is blameless;
The word of the LORD is tried;
He is a shield to all who take refuge in Him.

³¹ For who is God, but the LORD?
And who is a rock, except our God,

Psalms 33:5-7

⁵ He loves righteousness and justice;
The earth is full of the lovingkindness of the LORD.

⁶ **By the word of the LORD the heavens were made,**
And by the breath of His mouth all their host.

⁷ He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap;
He lays up the deeps in storehouses.

Psalms 119:88-90

⁸⁸ Revive me according to Your lovingkindness,
So that I may keep the testimony of Your mouth.

⁸⁹ Forever, O LORD,
Your word is settled in heaven.

⁹⁰ Your faithfulness *continues* throughout all generations;
You established the earth, and it stands.

Psalms 119:159-161

¹⁵⁹ Consider how I love Your precepts;
Revive me, O LORD, according to Your lovingkindness.

¹⁶⁰ The sum of Your word is truth,
And every one of Your righteous ordinances is everlasting.

¹⁶¹ Princes persecute me without cause,
But my heart stands in awe of Your words.

Proverbs 30:4-6

⁴ Who has ascended into heaven and descended?

Who has gathered the wind in His fists?

Who has wrapped the waters in His garment?

Who has established all the ends of the earth?

What is His name or His son's name?

Surely you know!

⁵ Every word of God is tested;

He is a shield to those who take refuge in Him.

⁶ Do not add to His words

Or He will reprove you, and you will be proved a liar.

Isaiah 40:7-9

⁷ The grass withers, the flower fades,
When the breath of the LORD blows upon it;
Surely the people are grass.

⁸ The grass withers, the flower fades,
But the word of our God stands forever.

⁹ Get yourself up on a high mountain,
O Zion, bearer of good news,
Lift up your voice mightily,
O Jerusalem, bearer of good news;
Lift *it* up, do not fear.
Say to the cities of Judah,
“Here is your God!”

Isaiah 45:22-24

²² “Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth;
For I am God, and there is no other.

²³ “I have sworn by Myself,
The word has gone forth from My mouth in righteousness
And will not turn back,

That to Me every knee will bow, every tongue will swear *allegiance*.

²⁴ “They will say of Me, ‘Only in the LORD are righteousness and strength.’
Men will come to Him,
And all who were angry at Him will be put to shame.

Isaiah 55:10-12

¹⁰ “For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven,
And do not return there without watering the earth
And making it bear and sprout,
And furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;

¹¹ So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;
It will not return to Me empty,
Without accomplishing what I desire,
And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it.

¹² “For you will go out with joy
And be led forth with peace;
The mountains and the hills will break forth into shouts of joy before you,
And all the trees of the field will clap *their* hands.

Jeremiah 8:8-10

⁸ “How can you say, ‘We are wise,
And the law of the LORD is with us’?
But behold, the lying pen of the scribes
Has made *it* into a lie.

⁹ “The wise men are put to shame,
They are dismayed and caught;
Behold, they have rejected the word of the LORD,
And what kind of wisdom do they have?

¹⁰ “Therefore I will give their wives to others,
Their fields to new owners;
Because from the least even to the greatest
Everyone is greedy for gain;
From the prophet even to the priest
Everyone practices deceit.

Hebrews 4:12-13 ¹² For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword,
and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the
thoughts and intentions of the heart. ¹³ And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things
are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.
